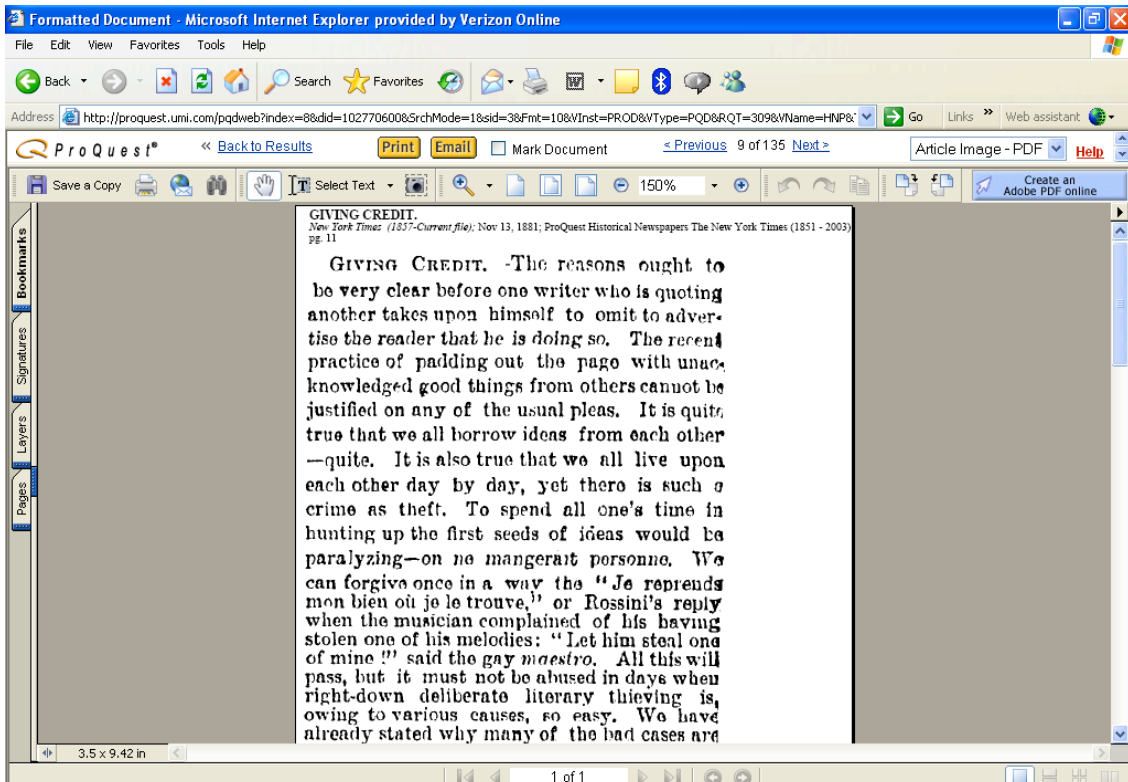

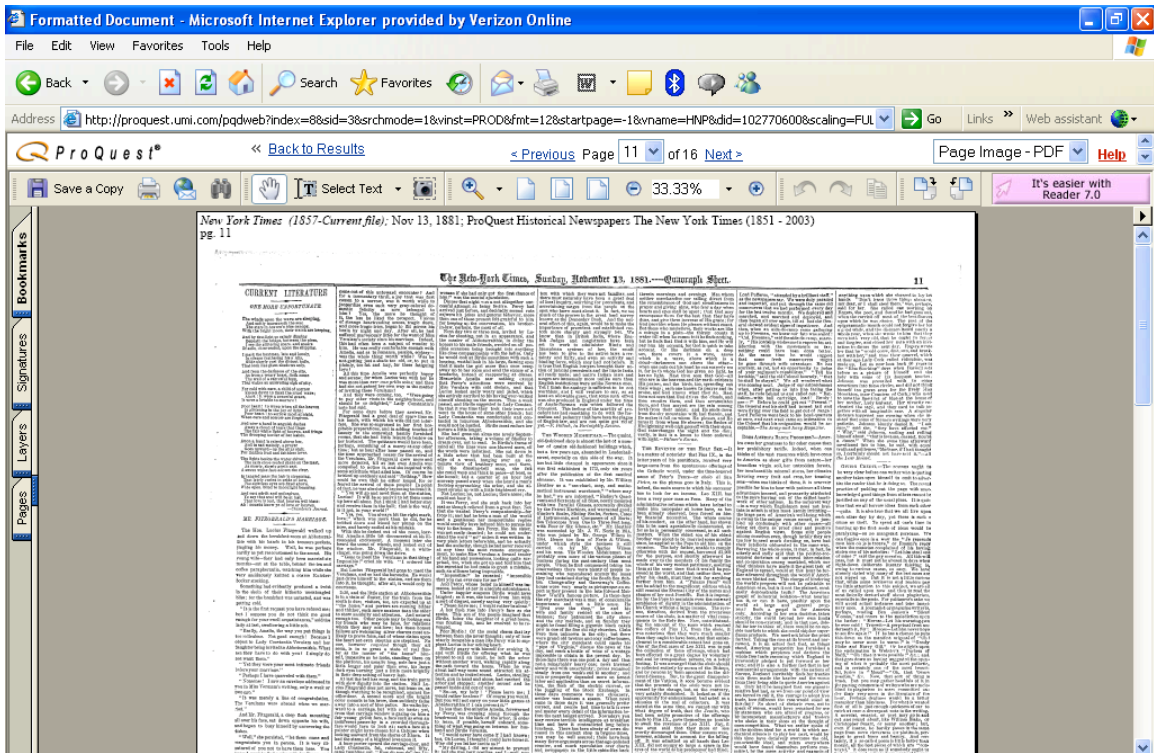

4. To view article image click on the link "Article image – PDF" to view as a PDF document.

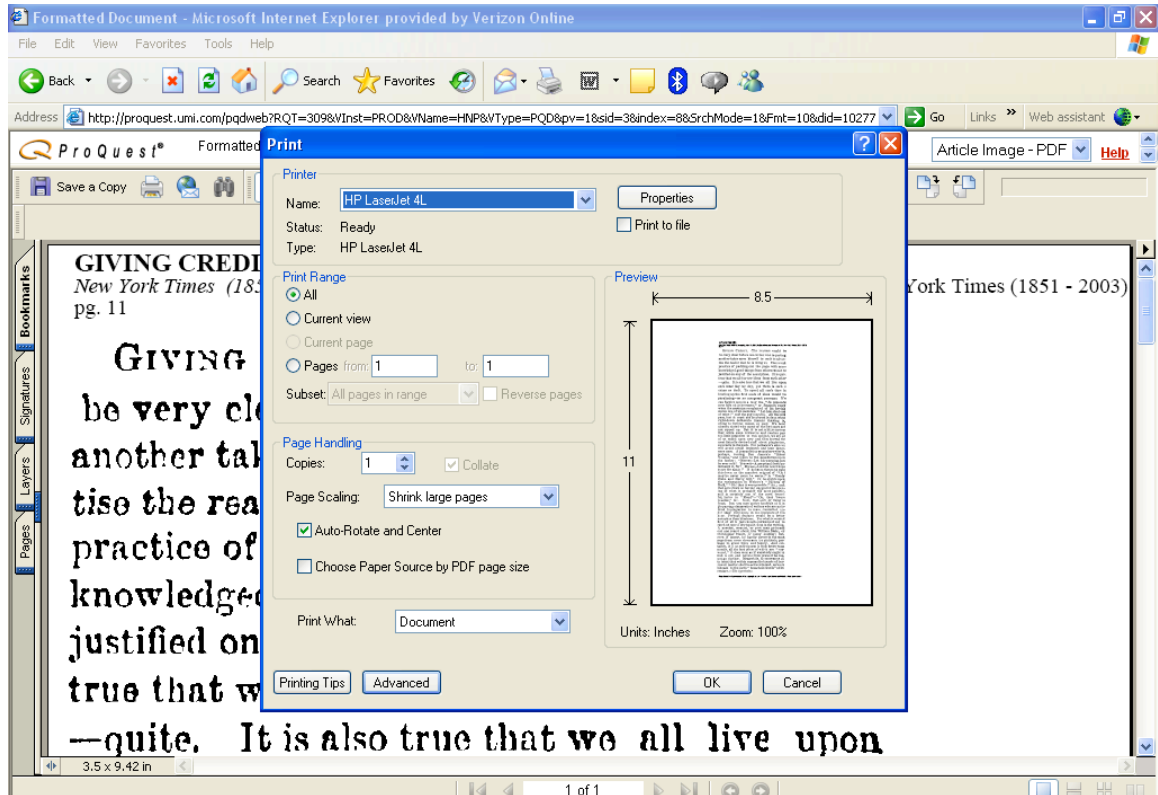


**NOTE:** To view the article in full page image click on the drop down menu in the upper right hand corner and select "Page Image – PDF".



## Print/E-mail/Save

5. From the full text page, to print the article click on the "Print" button.



6. In the Print window click on "Print"

## SAVE

7. Follow steps 1 through 4
8. Click on the Adobe browser's "Save a Copy"
9. From the "Save a Copy" menu, type in the name of your file, in the "File name" field, select where you want to save this file on your hard drive from the drop down menu and then click on the "Save" button.

## EMAIL

10. To Email, follow steps 1 and 2 above.

11. Enter your e-mail address, subject and comments (both optional)

12. Click on the "Send" button.
